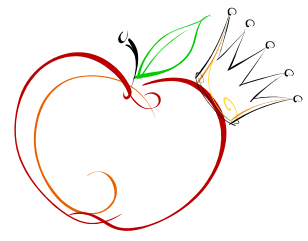

2019 Oak Harbor Apple Festival Royalty Contest

It's time again to begin the search for the new Apple Festival Royalty Court! On behalf of the Oak Harbor Area Chamber of Commerce and the reigning court, we are thrilled to extend this invitation to you! The Royalty Court will reign for a period of one year. They will have the opportunity to travel, learn about other communities in our state, meet many new friends, and gain experience speaking in public as they share with others information about our festival.

The Apple Festival Royalty Court consists of an Apple Queen and a 1st Attendant (Grades 9-11), Princess (Grades 6-8), Junior Princess (Grades 3-5), Johnny Appleseed and Apple Blossom (Grades K-2). All court members must attend the Benton-Carroll-Salem School District. Past Royalty members which have previously held a title (this excludes runners-up) may not compete for that particular title again. They may however compete for a different title.

Upon the successful completion of their reign, the Queen receives \$300.00, the Princess and Junior Princess receive \$100.00 each, and Johnny Appleseed and Apple Blossom receive \$50.00 each.

All contestants must complete the attached application. Please also add a wallet size photo to the application (not to be returned). The application must be turned in to the Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce by **Thursday, October 3 no later than 4:00pm**. Late applications will not be accepted.

The Preliminary Interviews will be held on **Monday, October 7, 2019 at 6:00pm** at Oak Harbor Public Library. The Library is located at 147 West Main Street, Oak Harbor. Please follow directional signing upon entering.

Enclosed you will find a schedule of events for preliminary judging and the day of the festival. Please be on time to ensure a relaxed and enjoyable evening. These interviews will determine the winners for Johnny Appleseed and Apple Blossom. The field for Queen, Princess and Junior Princess will be narrowed to the top three candidates each and will compete on **Saturday, October 12, 2019** for the titles. The interview will consist of a variety of questions, including but not limited to those on the Royalty application. Scoring will range from 1-5 in the following categories: Introduction, Speaking, Personality, Appearance, Stage Presence and knowledge of the Apple Festival and the Community. All scores are and will remain confidential. Preliminary interviews will be conducted by local business leaders and community members. The Oak Harbor Chamber and Royalty Committee reserve the right to make final decisions regarding reigning members of the royalty court. The Royalty Crowning is judged by independent judges from outside of the community: they are non-biased and their decision is final.

Please dress in nice, age-appropriate clothing; interview attire. No formals, jeans, flip-flops or tennis shoes are permitted.

Being a part of The Apple Festival Royalty Court is a big responsibility and it is very important that the potential royalty member and their parents and/or guardians understand the commitment that will be expected. Parents or guardian must accompany their child. A complete list of Rules and Guidelines for the Apple Festival Royalty may be obtained from the Chamber of Commerce Office.

If your son or daughter is selected as a winner or finalist, you must attend opening ceremonies on **Saturday, October 12 at 8:30am**. Dress code for the Royalty contest is the same as that for the Preliminary Interviews.

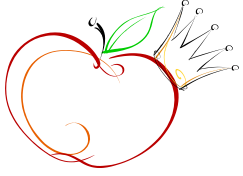

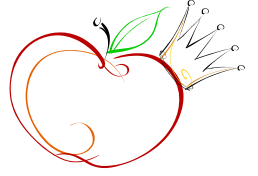
